Despre Connexions

Connexions este un serviciu guvernamental dedicat persoanelor tinere intre 13 si 19 ani, asigurand acestora informatie, sfaturi, indrumari si ajutor concret in asa fel incat sa poata obtine un loc de munca, sa primeasca instruirea potrivita sau sa intre intr-un sistem de invatamant cu program normal. Acest serviciu este asigurat de catre Consultanti Personali, angajati de catre Connexions.

Consultantii Personali lucreaza in scoli si colegii, in centre Connexions, in centre pentru tineri si centre comunitare precum si in multe alte agentii. Ei pot da informatii despre cariera, locuri de munca, cursuri de formare, voluntariat si oportunitati de instruire. Acestia ajuta si sprijina persoanele tinere sa inteleaga informatia, sa decida care oportunitati sunt mai bune pentru ei si sa isi planifice viitorul. Ei pot de asemenea sa ii ajute pe tineri daca acestia au probleme cu locuinta, banii, sanatatea sau drepturile lor si se pot asigura ca tinerii primesc ajutor specialist suplimentar atunci cand au nevoie.

Connexions raspunde tuturor persoanelor in mod egal, indiferent de trecutul acestora, de rasa, gen, religie, capacitate sau incapacitate, orientare sexuala sau varsta. Connexions poate asigura un translator pentru interviurile cu un Consultant Personal si poate asigura traducerea in scris a brosurilor informative, daca acest lucru este cerut.

What is Connexions?

Connexions is a government-funded service for all young people aged 13 to 19, giving them information, advice, guidance and practical help so that they can get a job, get the right training or go into a full-time education course. This service is given by trained Personal Advisers, who are employed by Connexions.

Personal Advisers work in schools and colleges, in Connexions centres, in youth and community centres and with many other agencies. They can give information about careers, jobs, education courses, working as a volunteer, and training opportunities. They help and support young people to understand the information, to decide what opportunities are best for them, and to plan for their future. They can also help young people if they are worried about housing, money, health and their rights and can arrange for young people to have more specialist help when needed.

Connexions treats people equally, irrespective of background, race, gender, religion, ability or disability, sexual orientation or age. Connexions can arrange for an interpreter for any interviews with a Personal Adviser, and can arrange for written information leaflets to be translated if this is required.
